South Texas Project

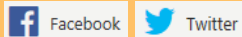

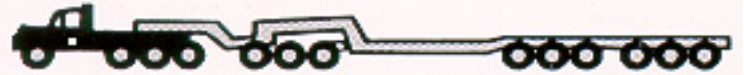

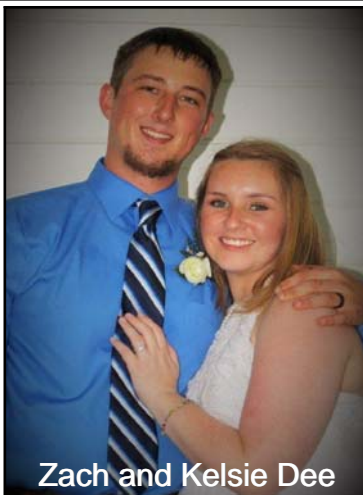
