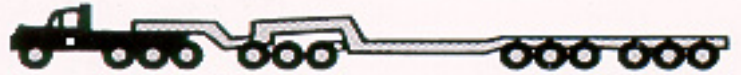

Kevin Roskres (900179) moved this blade mold from Texas to Grand Forks, North Dakota. He has worked for Lone Star since January 2007.



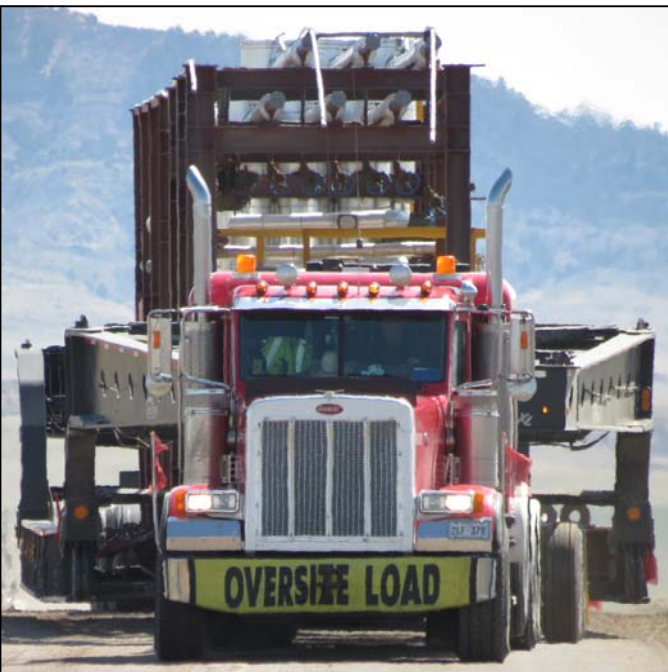

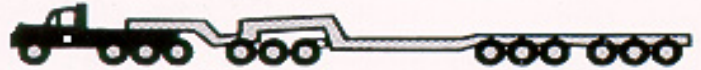


Mike Ptak (900327) loaded and hauled this 57M Vestas blade in Brighton, Colorado in May 2013, with Supervisors **Mike Hall** and **Jimmy Peeler**. Load dimensions were 212'6" L x 13' W x 14'2" H. This load had a 29'6" rear overhang.



Mark Lemon (900216) hauled this skid module from Big Cabin, OK to Estevan, Saskatchewan, Canada in May. Dimensions were 16' W x 16'6" H and 187' long.

More Lone Star Loads



Terry Irvin (900321) took this picture in April 2013 on Route 40, Rabbit Ears Pass, Steamboat Springs, Colorado, elevation of 9,429 feet. The load went from Bonanza, Utah to Houston, Texas.

Drivers Jose (Woody) Gamero (350052) and Leon Diaz (350058) hauled two of these crane girders from Houston to Saginaw, Texas. Dimensions were 110' L x 7' H x 5' W, and 37,700 pounds. Leon's had a catwalk and railing on it, and weight on his load was 43,750 pounds. →



Paul Howell (900313) delivered an Atlas Copco drill in February to Hycroft Gold Mine near Winnemucca, Nevada. Dimensions were 127'6" L x 16'4" W x 16'4" H and 229,000 pounds.



Nineteen loads were moved from Schertz, Texas to a Rockdale, Texas power plant from January 7th and continuing through January 30, 2013, starting at 4:00 a.m. every morning. The tallest load was 24' high and the widest load was 24'6" wide. Guadalupe County Sheriffs were with them from Schertz to Gonzales, and a Bexar County Sheriff ran with them from Schertz to the Guadalupe County line, and a Bexar County constable ran with them all the way on every load.

This wheel loader was loaded on the beam section designed and built by Lone Star. **Randy Collins (900249)** hauled it from Aurora, Illinois to Savannah, Georgia with **Mike Hall, Field Supervisor**. Dimensions were 44' L x 13'6" W x 13'7" H and 118,480 pounds.

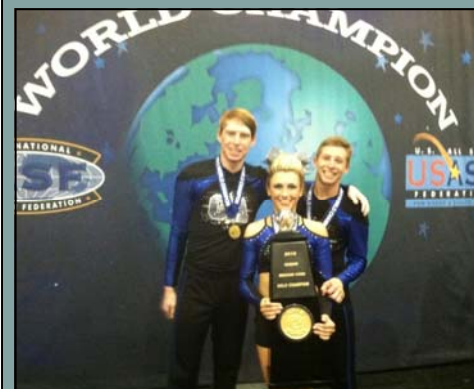
TexR Foundation News
